Step 1 Earn your K-12 Education minor by taking 6 required courses.

- SPED 2000 – Foundation of Exceptional Learners
- IDT 3600 – Technology in Education
- EDPR 3302 – Child and Adolescent Development
- ICL 4001 – Teaching/Diverse Environments

Step 2 Pass the Praxis exam for your major to earn a temporary teaching license.

Step 3 Enroll in a 5-course fast-track Graduate course sequence to earn your full teaching license.
